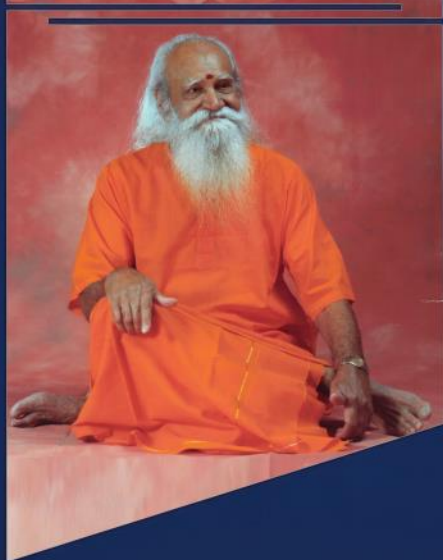

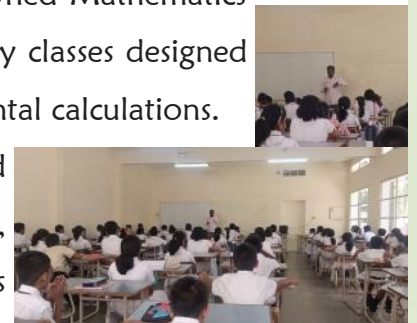
The informative and practical session was highly appreciated by both students and teachers, leaving everyone with valuable lessons on goal setting, curiosity, and basic emergency care.

The Indo-German Cultural Exchange Programme 2026 commenced with the arrival of 22 German students and 3 teachers from Königin-Luise-Gymnasium, Erfurt. The delegation was warmly received by our Managing Trustee, Secretary, and Principal, and welcomed to campus by our School Band, students, and staff.

Cultural Immersion & Learning

The exchange provided rich exposure to Indian heritage and arts. Students attended Tamil language classes, Classical Dance sessions to learn traditional mudras, Carnatic Music lessons, and Folk Dance practice. A special demonstration of the Olipadaitha Kanninai song deepened their appreciation for Tamil literature. Kolam drawing, Bhajans at dusk, and a cooking session on Chappathi, Tomato Sabji, and Kesari offered hands-on cultural experiences. Dr V. Ganesan's interactive talk on Indian culture, traditions, festivals, and classical arts further enriched their understanding of India's diversity.

Dr. S. Chandrasekar, Director – Strategic Sourcing, Plant Engineering & Corporate Relations, Roots Group of Companies, addressed the students on the Germany–India Round Table and engaged them in an interactive session, encouraging them to share their experiences and key takeaways from the Cultural Exchange Programme.

Local visits to a traditional Weaving Unit and Then Tirupathi temple introduced them to textile craftsmanship and regional traditions.

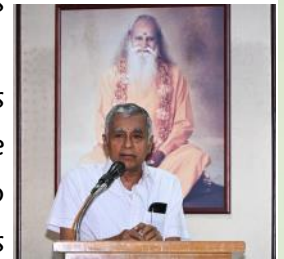
Indo-German Cultural Exchange Programme - Valedictory & Feedback Session **July 1, 2026**

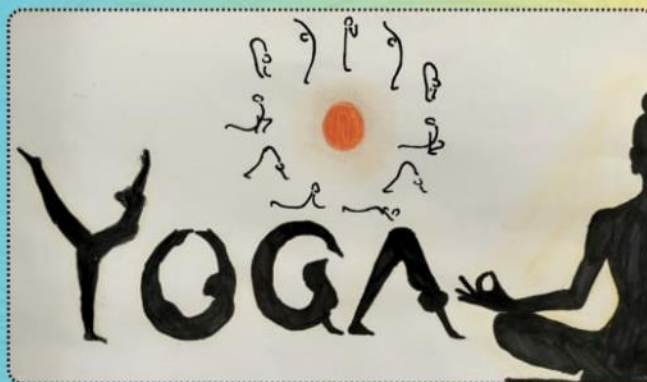

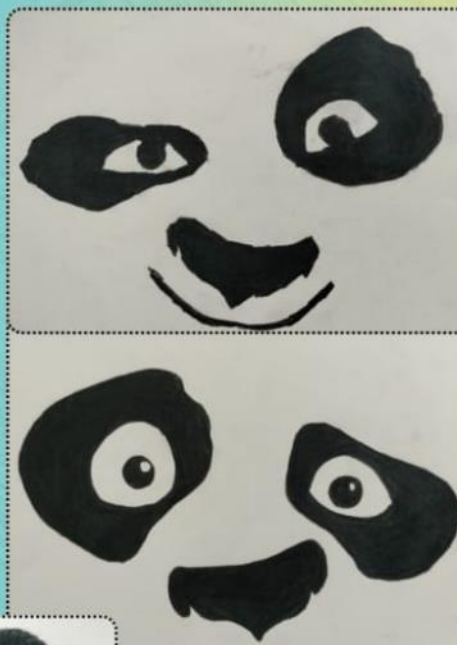

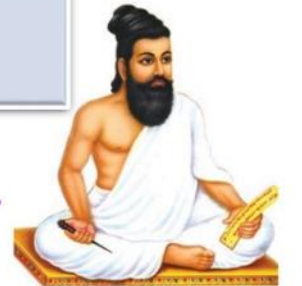
